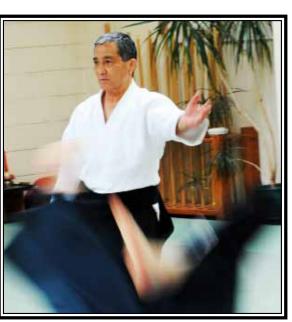

Shiohira Sensei

Shiohira Sensei has been training in and teaching Aikido for over 45 years. He began studying Aikido at Waseda University Aikikai under Shizuo Imaizumi Sensei. He also trained at Hombu Dojo and had one year

of live-in training under the second Doshu, Kisshomaru Ueshiba Sensei. He also received instruction from all of the other leading Aikikai World Headquarters instructors at the time, including O-Sensei (Founder), Kisshomaru Ueshiba Sensei (Second Doshu), Koichi Tohei Sensei (Chief Instructor), Kisaburo Osawa Sensei, Morihiro Saito Sensei, Seigo Yamaguchi Sensei, Sadateru Arikawa Sensei, and at Shingu, Michio Hikitsuchi Sensei. He studied Shin Shin Toitsu Aikido under Koichi Tohei Sensei (Founder)
